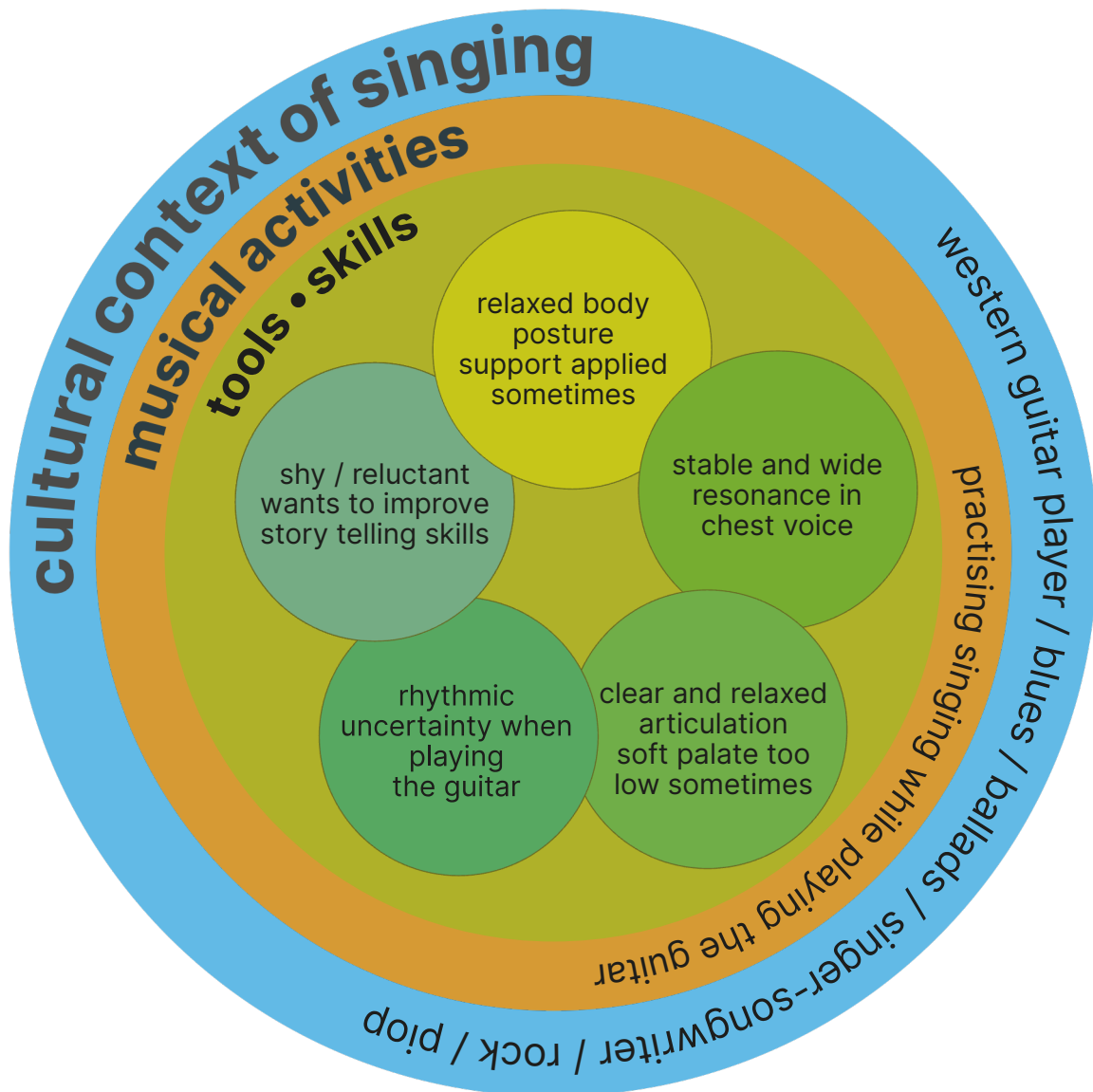


Use Case 1: Secondary Teacher Student



Example Applications in Vocal Training

Tools & Skills

- **Body:** Try out activating body exercises for more dynamic body posture
- **Sound:** Expand the comfort zone of resonating chest voice into higher pitches
- **Articulation:** use articulation as a vehicle to help expand the vocal range / activate & improve story telling skills
- **Style:** Practice at a slow tempo to coordinate voice and instrument (e.g., guitar)
- **Performance:** Use video self-recordings to develop performance skills in a safe environment

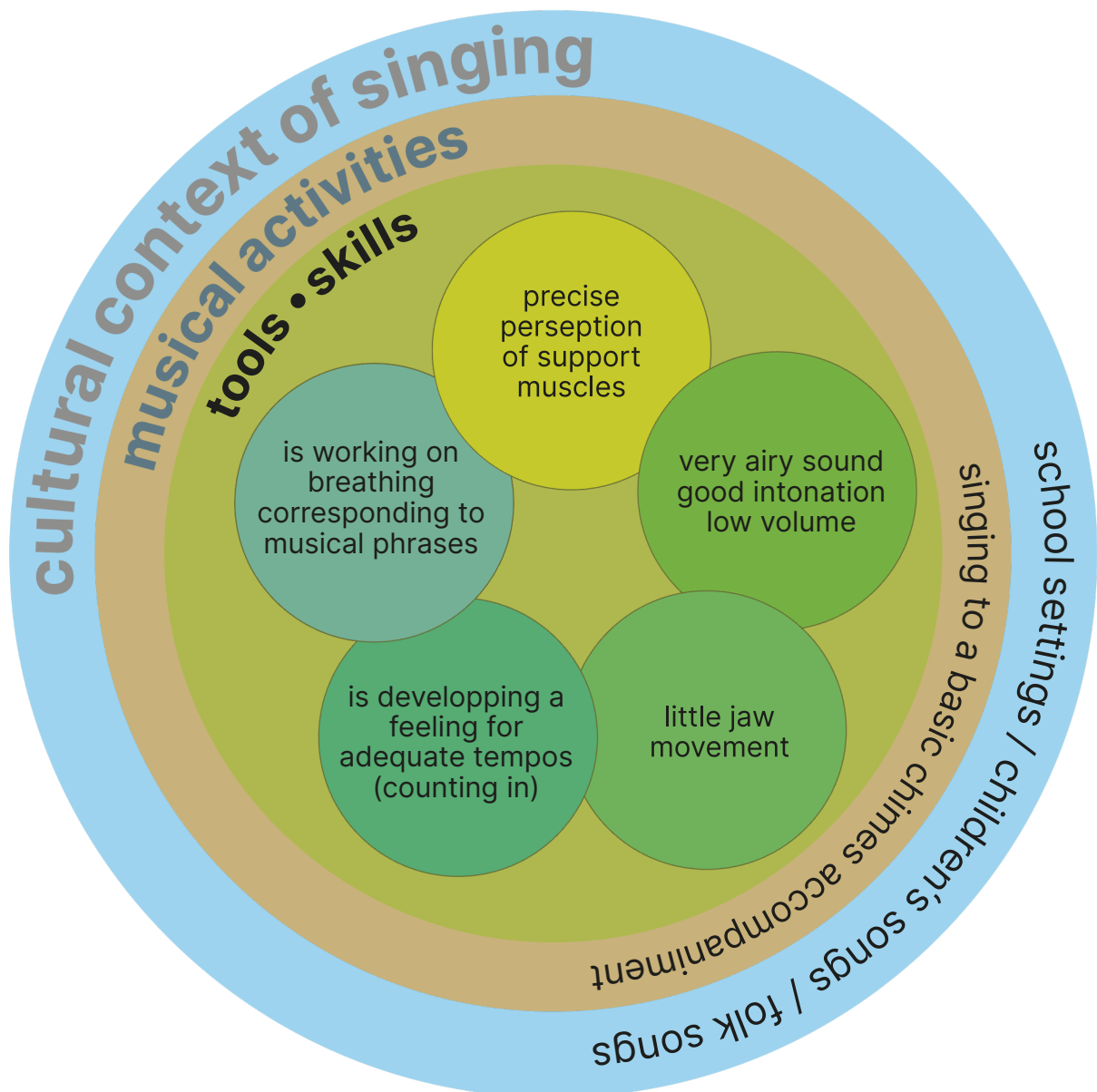
Musical Activities

Example Applications in Vocal Training

Tools & Skills

- **Body:** Engage support muscles to develop awareness of airflow and reduce excess air usage
- **Sound:** Explore a range of dynamics to improve efficient breath control
- **Articulation:** Use exercises to activate mouth and jaw movement, supporting greater dynamic range with less air
- **Style:** Apply counting exercises to strengthen audiation skills
- **Performance:** Shape musical phrases and coordinate breathing to enhance presence in the classroom
